Special General Meeting

Thank you everyone who attended. Both the resolutions were past with the new subscription year and new look rule book both starting on 1st May.

Recent Flood - Storm Ciara

This recent storm meant that North Yard was under water by about six inches, which is higher than long standing members have seen it (the flood level was 1.8m above prediction at one point). We have carried out a preliminary check and there doesn't seem to have been any major damage but we may be drying out under the clubhouse for a while yet.

Floodgate

The Environment Agency are now operating the new floodgate and in the event of a flood warning the floodgates will be shut up to 2 hours before high tide and opened shortly after once the flooding risk has receded. Access to the North Yard will only be by the promenade gate during this period.

The main floodgate will be tested each Wednesday morning and the test will take less than half an hour, during which time access to the wall and crane will be limited. The EA team have agreed to be helpful if anyone needs access during the test time.

Promenade Car Parking

As you are no doubt aware there were proposals made to restrict parking in the spaces on the promenade. Thank you to everyone who sent in objections. We have held a meeting with council officers about the parking proposals and have now been told that a revised scheme will go out to further consultation which will have a number of changes that we think will be ok for the club.
